Msgr. Ken Leone is a Pastor of the Church of the Risen Christ in Denver and Chaplain of The Father Raphael McCarthy Assembly #2294. He was born Feb. 24, 1941, in Denver, Kenneth Jerry Leone studied at St. Thomas Seminary and was ordained on May 27, 1967, at the Cathedral Basilica of the Immaculate Conception. After first serving as assistant pastor at Our Lady of Fatima Parish in Lakewood, he held the same position at Blessed Sacrament and at Christ the King parishes in Denver. Meantime, he served as coordinator of priests in Youth Work and was area youth director for the Denver Archdiocese. He was associate pastor at St. Thomas More Parish in Englewood from 1978-1981 and then served as pastor at Spirit of Christ Catholic Community in Arvada and later at St. Frances Cabrini Parish in Littleton. Today he is pastor at Risen Christ Parish in Denver. He too is a former dean for his deanery.
